Demonstrate knowledge of emergency situations, procedures, and responses on an infrastructure worksite

Describe health, safety, and environmental care at an infrastructure worksite

Working Safely and Responsibly

Apply safe work practices in the workplace

Demonstrate knowledge of good work habits and safe working practices on an infrastructure worksite

Workplace Professionalism

Describe and complete work records for an infrastructure worksite

Communicate in a team or group which has an objective.

Demonstrate knowledge of time management

Communicate with stakeholders on an infrastructure worksite

Maintaining and Using Tools and Small Machinery

Maintain small machinery used on infrastructure worksites

Use and care for hand tools used on an infrastructure worksite

Operate and care for small machinery used on an infrastructure worksite

Aggregates, Mixes, and Manual Excavation

Carry out manual excavation on an infrastructure worksite

Demonstrate knowledge of aggregates and mixes used on an infrastructure worksite
