

Power Up – Electricity Supply

Micro-credential in Introduction to the Electricity Supply Industry Gateway Programme (Level 2)

This programme introduces students to infrastructure's Electricity Supply Industry (ESI). This programme provides ESI foundational knowledge allowing students to understand the industry and be safe on an electricity supply worksite.

Students that complete this programme will have knowledge of the following:

- Health and safety duties when on electricity supply sites.
- The major sectors within the industry and the relationships between them.
- Electricity systems used in the electricity supply industry.
- Plant and equipment that can be found on electricity supply sites.

The programme is completed through theory assessments and can be completed through paper based workbooks or through eLearning.

This programme is also available through the free eLearning app called Totara. With the Totara app you can:

- quickly and securely access your eLearning programme whenever and wherever it suits you,
- download modules for offline learning,
- easily upload evidence for online assessment (such as photos or videos) straight from your phone,
- use phone apps and features such as speech-to-text and text-to-speech.

This programme offers a pathway into the electricity supply industry. Students may go on to complete further infrastructure Gateway programmes, or the New Zealand Certificate in Electricity Supply (Introductory) Level 2, which can lead to a variety of electricity supply apprenticeships and programmes in the industry.
