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MC *Temporary Traffic Management Risk Assessment*



This course is designed for professionals with a health and safety role or responsibility in ensuring safe outcomes for activities conducted in, or impacting, the road corridor.

This includes anyone involved in temporary traffic management design, engineering, corridor management, planning, reviewing, assurance, regulatory and/or network access functions.

WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

This course covers the knowledge and skills required to manage risk, and to complete a risk assessment for an activity requiring temporary traffic management.

It covers:

- Understanding and being able to describe the principles and processes for managing risk;
- Using skills and knowledge to complete a risk assessment for an activity requiring temporary traffic management.

HOW THE COURSE IS DELIVERED

This course is delivered through a combination of online learning and assessment, a one-day workshop, and an on-job practical assessment.

Learners are supported by a Customer Service Account Manager and assessor throughout their training.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To enrol for this course, learners must already work in temporary traffic management and be exposed to the skills covered. Learners must be able to provide evidence of risk assessment for a temporary traffic management activity from their workplace.

PROGRESSION PATHWAYS

Graduates who hold this micro-credential will be able to continue their training within temporary traffic management by completing a micro-credential in Temporary Traffic Management Design Level 4 or further micro-credentials as they become available.

WHAT IS A MICRO-CREDENTIAL?

A micro-credential is a short, NZQA-recognised training course where you can earn between 5-40 credits when successfully completed. Micro-credential courses either lead to a qualification or focus on specialised skills and knowledge that top-up a full qualification certificate, or apprenticeship programme.
