# MC *Temporary Traffic Management Design*



This course is designed for people who develop traffic management plans and need to understand the importance of, and principles behind, robust risk assessment and management.

It includes skills required to address the safety of relevant personnel who work with traffic management plans, including workers on a road or roadside temporary traffic management activity.

## WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

This course covers the knowledge and skills required to develop a traffic management plan for an activity requiring temporary traffic management.

It covers:

- Compiling a solution for an activity requiring temporary traffic management.
- Preparing traffic management plan information for an activity.
- Consulting with relevant stakeholders who carry out the requirements of the traffic management plan.

## HOW THE COURSE IS DELIVERED

This course is delivered through a combination of online learning and an on-job practical assessment.

Learners are supported by a Customer Service Account Manager and assessor throughout their training.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To enrol for this course, learners must already work in temporary traffic management and be exposed to the skills covered.

Learners must be able to provide evidence of one or more traffic management plans that they have developed.

Evidence of traffic management plans need to cover five of the following factors:

- Low speed  $\leq 60$  km/hr
- High speed  $\geq 70$  km/hr
- Presence of vulnerable road users
- Multi-lane
- Motorway
- Intersections

It is highly recommended that learners hold the Micro-credential in Temporary Traffic Management Risk Assessment Level 4 or can demonstrate equivalent skills and knowledge.

## TRAINING PATHWAYS

On successful completion of this micro-credential, learners will be able to continue their training within temporary traffic management by completing further micro-credentials as they become available.

## WHAT IS A MICRO-CREDENTIAL?

A micro-credential is a short, NZQA-recognised training course where you can earn between 5-40 credits when successfully completed. Micro-credential courses either lead to a qualification or focus on specialised skills and knowledge that top-up a full qualification certificate, or apprenticeship programme.
