## Dig It - Civil Gateway Programme

Introduction to Infrastructure Works (Level 2, 18-25 Credits)

This programme introduces students to the civil infrastructure industry, and is for students in Year 11, 12 or 13.

At the completion of this programme, students will:

- Demonstrate and apply knowledge of safe work habits and emergency procedures on an infrastructure worksite.
- Be able to use hand tools, small machinery and/or excavate manually.
- Have an understanding of the infrastructure industry.

This programme is a combination of theory and practical units and can be completed through workbooks or eLearning. This programme is also available through the free eLearning app 'Totara'. Totara allows quick and secure access to eLearning programmes, courses and assessment activities whenever and wherever it suits.

Upon completion, this programme offers a pathway to the *Breaking Ground - Infrastructure Worksites (Level 3)* programme or the *New Zealand Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Level 2).* 

#### Dig It - Civil Gateway Programme includes:

- Gateway information.
- Learner assessment and notes or eLearning logins for online resources.

#### **Unit Standards**

To complete the *Dig It - Civil Gateway Programme*, the student must complete the unit standards in the table. The three mandatory units must be completed by all students.

Please tick the chosen electives for the student in the table; a minimum of 5 credits (approx. two units) and a maximum of 12 credits (approx. four units) must be selected.

Elective units should be chosen carefully to align with the student's workplace placement, in discussion with their placement company. When selecting electives, ensure the student will have the opportunity to gather the required evidence with the company during their placement.
