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## NZA Bitumen Surfacing Construction



This course is designed for people who are involved in preparing and completing bitumen surfacing construction works.

It includes skills required to assess the site, implement work processes, operate equipment, ensure health and safety and support a team on-site.

### WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

- Assess a job site to confirm preparation work is complete and resources are available for bitumen surfacing work.
- Confirm job requirements and carry out job instructions to meet specifications, escalating any changes as needed.
- Identify and assess risks to maintain safety for everyone on site
- Support the team to complete bitumen surfacing work to specifications.

### **HOW THE COURSE IS DELIVERED**

This programme is assessed on-job and is completed through workbooks. It can also be achieved through Advanced Portfolio Assessment (APA). If the learner has a minimum of 4 years experience working in the industry, and can provide a portfolio of evidence from the past 24 months linking to the level of this programme's unit standards, then APA could be a great option to recognise existing skills.

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

The learner must be employed in the bitumen surfacing industry and be exposed to the relevant skills covered. The learner must have the appropriate class of driver licence and endorsement for any vehicle being driven.

## TRAINING PATHWAYS

This qualification can lead towards Civil Trade Certification (CTC). Learners can also continue their recognised pathways to the NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Single Site Supervision) (Level 4), the NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Projects) (Level 5) or the NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Contract Management) (Level 5).
