NZA Forestry Earthworks



This course is designed for people who are constructing and maintaining forestry infrastructure.

It includes skills required to work with environmental, sustainable and safety standards, enabling them to work safely with others to meet worksite requirements.

WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

- Reading and making plans for forestry earthworks
- Construct culverts and structures for a forestry earthworks site
- How to work within environmental, sustainable and safety standards
- Working in a team and with other forestry users
- Meeting worksite requirements using flexible work practices
- Apply risk assessment to ensure healthy and safe outcomes on site.

HOW THE COURSE IS DELIVERED

This programme is assessed on-job and is completed through workbooks. It can also be achieved through Advanced Portfolio Assessment (APA). If the learner has a minimum of 4 years experience working in the industry, and can provide a portfolio of evidence from the past 24 months linking to the level of this programme's unit standards, then APA could be a great option to recognise existing skills.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The learner must be employed in the forestry earthworks industry and be exposed to the relevant skills covered.

TRAINING PATHWAYS

This qualification can lead towards Civil Trade Certification (CTC). Graduates can also carry on to the NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Single Site Supervision) (Level 4), NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Projects) (Level 5) or the NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Contract Management) (Level 5).
