

This application form is for assessors applying to become an APA Assessor with Connexis. Advance Portfolio Assessment (APA) is carried out by experienced Connexis assessors.

To apply, to become an APA assessor the assessor must meet the following criteria:

- Be experienced as an assessor for a period of no less than two years.
- Hold the relevant qualification(s) or provide evidence of equivalent knowledge and skills.
- Demonstrate skills and experience within the elected field and level of expertise.
- Hold relevant industry registration.

Once recommended:

- Attend and satisfactorily complete the APA assessor training provided by Connexis
 Quality Assurance team. This training includes skills to conduct quality professional
 discussions and assess various documents such as CV's, prior qualifications, logbooks,
 and contracts).
- Assess two APA learners and submit the assessment evidence for moderation.
- Have two initial assessments approved by the allocated moderator.
- Sign an APA Terms of Reference (ToR).
- If registering as an External APA Assessor, sign the Service Level Agreement and apply the APA assessment fees accordingly.
