MC *Temporary Traffic Management (TTM): Monitoring TTM Controls*



This course is designed for people who are currently working in Temporary Traffic Management who are responsible for monitoring and maintaining static TTM controls to ensure safety, and quality assurance on worksites.

WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

This course covers the knowledge and skills required to monitor and maintain temporary traffic management controls.

It covers:

- Completing site briefings and inductions in line with the Traffic Management Plan (TMP), the risk assessment, and organisational requirements.
- Verifying the risk assessment, identifying new risks, and checking that the TMP is still fit for purpose.
- Maintaining site and situational awareness, including identifying risk and actioning responses to risk onsite.
- Monitoring TTM controls and site conditions.
- Communicating new or changing site conditions to personnel and escalating issues in line with organisational requirements.
- Understanding emergency response procedures for a TTM worksite.
- Maintaining onsite records, including completing required paperwork and reading a TMP.

HOW THE COURSE IS DELIVERED

This course is delivered through a combination of online learning and assessment, and an on-job practical assessment.

Learners are supported by a Customer Service Account Manager and assessor throughout their training.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To enrol for this course, trainees must already work in temporary traffic management, be exposed to the skills covered, and have access to a temporary traffic management worksite to complete on-job practical assessments.

TRAINING PATHWAYS

Graduates who hold this micro-credential will be able to continue their training within temporary traffic management by completing further Level 4 temporary traffic management micro-credentials.

WHAT IS A MICRO-CREDENTIAL?

A micro-credential is a short, NZQA-recognised training course where you can earn between 5-40 credits when successfully completed. Micro-credential courses either lead to a qualification or focus on specialised skills and knowledge that top-up a full qualification certificate, or apprenticeship programme.
