# **MC** *Temporary Traffic Management (TTM) System: Foundation Principles*



**This course is designed for people who need foundational knowledge of the Temporary Traffic Management system, including its principles, roles, and regulatory requirements, to support safe TTM practices.**

## **WHAT YOU'LL LEARN**

This course covers the knowledge and skills to understand the requirements for the temporary traffic management system.

It covers:

- Understanding the TTM framework and the core elements needed for a successful TTM system, including people, processes, equipment, and contracts.
- Legislation requirements and local council by laws in terms of operational practice for an activity requiring TTM.
- Understanding operational roles and responsibilities and the Health and Safety at Work Act. Engineering principles and operational practices applied to an activity requiring TTM.
- The function, impact, installation, operation, maintenance, and uplift of TTM controls.
- Operational practices and their alignment with the Traffic Management Plan (TMP), regulatory, and organisational requirements for an activity requiring TTM.
- Regulatory and organisational requirements for documentation and reporting procedures for an activity requiring TTM.

## **HOW THE COURSE IS DELIVERED**

This course is delivered through online learning and assessment.

Learners are supported by a Customer Service Account Manager and assessor throughout their training.

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

To enrol for this course, trainees must already work in temporary traffic management, be exposed to the skills covered and have access to a temporary traffic management worksite to meet the on-job requirements for this programme.

## **TRAINING PATHWAYS**

Graduates who hold this micro-credential will be able to continue their training within temporary traffic management by completing further Level 4 temporary traffic management micro-credentials.

## **WHAT IS A MICRO-CREDENTIAL?**

A micro-credential is a short, NZQA-recognised training course where you can earn between 5-40 credits when successfully completed. Micro-credential courses either lead to a qualification or focus on specialised skills and knowledge that top-up a full qualification certificate, or apprenticeship programme.
