<p>Trip / Falling</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Visitors shall be protected from tripping or falling through constant supervision and monitoring.</li> <li>2. Barriers, covers and edge protection will be used in instances there may be a risk.</li> </ol>		<p>Site Escort/Site Manager</p>
<p>Noise Proximity to plant and machinery operation</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Visitors will be removed from the immediate vicinity of the source of any plant or machinery noise, where there is an immediate risk of hearing damage.</li> <li>2. Where this control is unable to be reasonably implemented, visitors must be issued with hearing protection and instructions on its use.</li> </ol>		<p>Site Escort/Site Manager</p>
<p>Pedestrian interaction Struck by moving vehicles</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Visitors shall be issued and wear hi-vis vests.</li> <li>2. Visitors shall be issued and wear hard hats if required.</li> <li>3. Visitors shall be briefed on exclusion zones around mobile plant.</li> <li>4. Mobile Plant operation shall require the allocation of a spotter.</li> <li>5. Mobile plant movements shall require the allocation of a spotter.</li> <li>6.
