The Government is replacing NCEA from 2028.

The eight ISBs have been asked to scope and design 8-10 industry-led subjects.

Subjects aim to support broad industry pathways, rather than specific occupations.

Align with what employers value, while remaining accessible in a school context.

Industry-led subjects will have the same standing as Ministry-led subjects.

Timeline

- May/June. Scoping and pitching to the minister.
- July-Feb. Curriculum development.
- Feb and June 2027. Public consultation.
- 2028. Pilot in schools.
